

# Linux User Management

## Create User

- `useradd`
  - Native binary compiled with the system
  - Creates only a user by default (you have to use switches) to specify home directories and other settings
- `adduser`
  - Perl script which uses `useradd` among others
  - More user friendly and interactive
  - Creates a fully functional user on the system by default

## Groups

### Create Group

```
groupadd examplegroup
```

### Add user to group

```
usermod -a -G examplegroup exampleusername
```

```
adduser exampleusername examplegroup
```

### Remove user from group

```
adduser exampleusername examplegroup
```

### Change user's primary group

```
usermod -g groupname username
```
